Who May Apply?

The Steve Turner Williams Scholarship was established for students who:

- are members of a Southwest Region Conference church, or
- reside in the Southwest Region Conference states of Louisiana, Arkansas, Oklahoma, Texas, or New Mexico,
- will be enrolled in a college/university as a Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in Spring 2026,
- have a minimum GPA of 2.5, and
- have at least 30 documented hours in active community service.

Application Process

Please complete the entire application in English. Only completed and legible applications will be considered; do not leave any item blank.

The deadline to submit an application and all supporting documents is **January 7**, **2026**. Please enclose the following along with your application:

- College/university transcript and
- Three signed letters of recommendation from non-family, professional references, one of which must be your church's pastor or community services director.

To receive funds, applicants must produce confirmation of enrollment in a college/university by January 31, 2026.


Scholarship recipients will be determined by **January 21, 2026** and announced on January 23, 2026. Funds will be dispersed on **February 5, 2026**.
